(CHURCH LANE, CHARNOCK RICHARD, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Church Lane, Charnock Richard from its junction with Preston Road to its junction with Leeson Avenue.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2020 until 1700 hours on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> August 2020 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Preston Road – Chorley Lane – Church Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Electricity North West to install HV cable works to be carried out.
