(CHURCH LANE, CHARNOCK RICHARD, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Church Lane, Charnock Richard at point of the railway bridge travelling in either direction for approximately 20 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative over 5 consecutive weekends as follows:-

From 2330 hours on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2020 until 0900 hours on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2020

From 2330 hours on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> October 2020 until 0900 hours on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2020

From 2330 hours on Saturday 31st October 2020 until 0900 hours on Sunday 1st November 2020

From 2330 hours on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2020 until 0900 hours on Sunday 8th November 2020

From 2330 hours on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2020 until 0900 hours on Sunday 15th November 2020

4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Church Lane - Chorley Lane - Charter Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Rail bridge repair works to be carried out.
